

Physician Assistants & Nurse Practitioners

PHYSICIAN ASSISTANTS (PAs) are healthcare professionals licensed and credentialed by the federal government to practice medicine with physician supervision. PA's education follows the medical model, which is designed to complement that of the physician. They exercise autonomy in medical decision-making and provide a broad range of diagnostic and therapeutic services, which were traditionally conducted by physicians. They deliver a range of medical and surgical services including conducting physical examinations, ordering and interpreting diagnostic tests, prescribing medications, and relaying patient information.

A NURSE PRACTITIONER (NP) is a registered nurse (RN) who has completed advanced education (a minimum of a master's degree) and training in the diagnosis and management of common medical conditions, including chronic illnesses. Nurse Practitioners provide a broad range of health care services. They provide some of the same care provided by physicians and maintain close working relationships with physicians. A NP can serve as a patient's regular healthcare provider.

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
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Ryan Bowman, PA-C
